The Results

2 from the 3 wage studies into wage setting processes, industry and employment contexts were conducted. **Meetings with stakeholders** were organised in Ethiopia and Kenya.

Field research for 3 living wage benchmark studies took place (Ethiopia, Kenya and Tanzania).

1 publication in which the business case for a living wage and true price rose is explored from the grower and retailer perspective.

2 Roundtables “Blooming Conversation on Responsible Business” organised in Kenya & Ethiopia, attended by more than 60 representatives.
